Our school

Pupils

- Children and young people with special educational needs in the area of intellectual development

This means:

The pupils need special support in all areas of learning.

- Approximately 135 pupils
- Approximately 8 pupils per class

Teachers

- Special school teachers and special education specialists
- Lessons with 2 or 3 teachers



Opening hours

- Early care: from 7:00 a.m.
- Teaching hours: Monday to bis Thursday from 7:45 a.m. to 2:45 p.m.
Friday from 7:45 a.m. to 0:30 p.m.
- Late care: until 4:00 p.m.

Meals

- Breakfast and lunch
- Costs for breakfast and lunch according to the food supplier's price list



Care

- Free lessons and care
- Holiday care for children up to 12 years of age whose parents are working



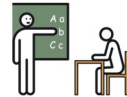
Specialized transport service

Our school's goals

Pupils should learn to live independently.

At our school, pupils learn practical life skills.

This means:

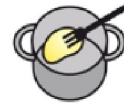
Pupils practice coping with everyday life.

For example:

We go shopping for groceries.

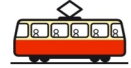


We cook meals together.



On practical days, we do laundry together.

We travel together by bus and train.



We prepare pupils in the upper classes “Werkstufe” for adult life.



Pupils learn about different professions.

For example:

Pupils work with wood.

They do laundry.

They clean the Erfurt Zoo.



Full-day lessons

The pupils are personally supported through a variety of learning opportunities.

The pupils learn important skills in our culture.

For example:

They learn to read and write.

They learn to count money.

The pupils sing together.

They learn to play an instrument.



They paint and do crafts.



They create things with clay.

Together, we organise seasonal highlights of our culture.

For example:

Christmas celebrations, carneval, eastern, autumn and spring festivals.



Pupils also learn at learning locations outside of school.

For example:

City tours and museum visits.



We offer various sports activities and swimming lessons.

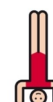
Pupils take part in sports festivals.



Pupils choose from a range of courses.

For example:

Acrobatics, theatre or design.



We offer basal support for pupils with multiple disabilities.

Basal means: with all the senses.

For example:

Snoezelen room or basal stories.

Pupils can relax in the Snoezelen room.



We offer various exercise programmes.

For example:

With exercise ball, roller board or medical walking aid.



Therapeutic support

Our pupils receive therapeutic support as needed.

For example:

- Physiotherapy or occupational therapy to improve mobility
- Speech therapy to improve pronunciation
- Autism support



The therapies take place at the school.
